Committed to transforming lives after domestic violence

A Safe Place provides emergency shelter, affordable transitional and permanent housing, a 24-hour help line, court and non-legal advocacy; individual, group, and children's counseling; family visitation services; batterer intervention services; and community outreach, prevention education, and professional training. Clients come to us from across the state, region, and country. A Safe Place serves more than 16,000 individuals a year with its range of services for victims and their children.



At A Safe Place, we are dedicated to transforming lives after domestic violence. In the United States, 1 in 3 women and 1 in 7 men will be affected by domestic violence in their lifetime. An estimated **65,000 children in Lake County** will witness or experience domestic violence, powerless to stop it. Intervening and helping children overcome this trauma is critical to ending the cycle of domestic violence.



We want to share one story with you, to show you why we work so hard to end this epidemic.

"Growing up, violence was normal in our household. You could tell when dad walked through the door that it was going to be a bad night. I'd sleep in bed with my little brother when you could hear it through the walls, him yelling and furniture bumping. You could hear mom scream and we knew he hit her. My brother was scared. So was I but I had to be brave for him.

But he was still our dad. We just thought that's how families are, they fight. We begged mom to leave after a really bad night where he pushed her down the stairs and we slept in the car in the middle of winter. She said she didn't know where we would go. We couldn't sleep in the car forever to escape him. We stayed a few days, sleeping in the car, until he found us, apologizing like crazy to my mom and me.

He wasn't sorry for very long though, and the abuse eventually turned to me when I would try to stop him from hitting mom. This continued for about 2 years. I started faking sick so I could be home with mom. I was so scared of what he would do to her if I wasn't there. But then my teacher started getting worried because I was missing so much school and when I was in school, I was either totally uninterested or really angry.

I was in the nurse's office with another stomachache when she talked to me about A Safe Place. As soon as I got home, I told mom we had a place we could go. We stayed in the emergency shelter and got an order of protection to keep him away from us. A weight was lifted. One that I didn't even know I was carrying. The first night, I met other kids who had experienced similar things and realized I wasn't alone. I started to feel like a normal kid again. I was able to stop lashing out at friends who asked me if I was okay, I started enjoying school again (instead of worrying about having to go home).

In May I ran a 5k for A Safe Place. No one knew that they had helped us, but I wanted to run for all the kids like me who don't know what to do in these situations. My mom, my brother, and I are so thankful for everything they've done. I know now that it's not normal, and I know that I will never make my child feel the way I did."
